

LEARNING TO THRIVE IN A CARING ENVIRONMENT

We believe a safe and stable home life is key to unlocking a child's long-term potential.

Since 1968, Eagle Village has been changing the lives of youth and families. Set in rural Hersey, Michigan, our peaceful, 681-acre wooded campus became a home for 10-17 year-old boys and girls who have been abused or neglected.

Drawing upon decades of experience with trauma-impacted children, Eagle Village has designed programs that reach the individual needs children have.

- Family Involvement: We provide family experiences to address critical issues and challenges families are encountering, and we try to remove any obstacles to family involvement. This includes covering food and lodging for families here for therapy, and providing transportation to and from our campus. Including the whole family in the treatment plan is one key way to achieve lasting change.
- Therapy in Motion: Our trained therapists weave hands-on experiences and challenging, structured activities into treatment plans to aide therapy and teach social skills.
- Make a Plan: Trauma manifests in a range of behavioral and emotional struggles. Our skilled therapy team assesses the impact of each child's past traumatic experiences then develops a treatment plan for each child. We work with each child's strengths and teach them coping skills that will help prevent their struggles from blocking their success.

At Eagle Village, we believe in the potential of all people regardless of their story.





RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS

Eagle Village Residential Programs are designed by mental health professionals to achieve lasting results.

Connections: Mental Health Behavior Stabilization: 1:3 STAFF TO YOUTH RATIO Serving male and female youth between the ages of 8 to 17, Connections is most effective for children with adjustment issues due to trauma. To stabilize and treat the conditions and symptoms youth are experiencing, intensive evidence-based programming and trauma-informed therapeutic services are utilized. The program is designed to meet the psychological, emotional, behavioral, physical, and spiritual needs of the youth and family.

Passages: A Pathway to Independence

Designed for teenagers from 16 to 18, Passages prepares teens for adult life and equips them with the necessary tools for a successful transition to community living. Youth receive vocational and daily decision-making opportunities that help them craft a path for success. Academic assessments ensure an opportunity for high school graduation, and our Career and Trades Program gives teens a chance to earn certifications and develop workplace soft skills such as teamwork, communication, problem solving, and work ethic. Participants also receive weekly individual and group counseling.



PROGRAMS INCLUDE:

- Individual and group therapy with a trauma-infused approach
- On-campus sessions for the entire family (transportation and lodging provided at no cost to the family)
- Scheduled program activities, including on-campus hiking trails, fitness center, adventure equipment, and a sensory room
- Victors Edge Resiliency Training teaches kids how to control their responses to situations and to seek out their own methods for success
- On-campus Chapel services and access to our Campus Pastor, if desired
