# TAKING KIDS & FAMILIES TO THE NEXT LEVEL

Eagle Village has been utilizing the camp model for intervention purposes since we began over 50 years ago. Today, we continue to use the successful philosophies and theories of camp programming to help youth and their families press the restart button throughout the year.

Our staff members are trained to use techniques specific to kids with past trauma and emotional impairments to deal with:

- Defiance
- Depression
- Self-harm
- Lack of respect
- Extreme anger
- Bad attitudes
- Risky behaviors

Eagle Village uses challenging activities like canoeing, wilderness camping, mastering high ropes, and hiking in nature to serve as teachers. The activities teach natural consequences, decision making, trust, self-worth, perseverance, and goal setting in a true hands-on manner. For individual teens or entire families, Eagle Village's Short-Term Intervention Programs change attitudes and set a baseline for success.

## YOUTH CHALLENGE WEEKENDS/RESPITE

### **YOUTH CHALLENGE WEEKENDS**

Designed for youth from ages 9 to 17 who are experiencing behavioral and emotional challenges. Students will learn important concepts like respect and anger management while giving parents a weekend respite. Food and lodging for the weekend are included. Youth Challenge Weekends begin on Friday evening and end on Saturday afternoon.

### **YOUTH CHALLENGE RESPITE DAY PROGRAM**

We offer a day only option for youth who aren't yet ready to stay away from home, or when Saturday-only respite care is preferred. The Respite Day Program is a full day experience on Saturday. \*Only one weekend per camper, per month.

*January 9 / January 23 / February 6 / February 20 / March 6 / March 20 / April 10 / April 24  
Weekend Cost: \$150 per participant / Day Cost: \$125 per participant*

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, the current program is a day-only option. If restrictions are eased, overnight options may be added. If additional restrictions are imposed, this program may be cancelled and registered participants will be notified.

### **FAMILY INTERVENTIONS**

Family interventions are half- or a full-day experience designed for a single family to participate in together. These interventions are created to focus on the family's specific issue. We use experiential therapy to meet the individual needs of your family.

*Cost: \$150 per half-day; \$200 per full-day*

# SPECIALIZED SUMMER CAMPS

Eagle Village camps are best suited for kids and youth that are struggling to manage their anger or sadness, lacking respect for themselves or others, suffering from Reactive Attachment Disorder, or having problems taking personal responsibility.

## **SUMMER DAY CAMP:**

Summer day camp at Eagle Village provides respite for youth and families and positive experiences that give kids opportunities to experience success, build positive relationships with supportive adult mentors, and develop skills to strengthen resiliency. These day camps are for kids ages 6-17.

This summer, a 5-week program is being offered that includes 4 day programs and the option of an overnight experience at the end of the summer. Youth may participate in all four Fridays or just a few.

*June 25 / July 2 / July 9 / July 23 - Cost: \$125 per day*

Summer Day Camp Optional Overnight Experience:

Campers may choose an overnight option to enjoy two days of programming.

*Overnight Experience A: July 26-27 / Overnight Experience B: July 28-29*

## **SUMMER CAMP: BASE CAMP**

Base Camp is a 5-day camp experience for kids from ages 9 to 11. The program focuses on giving campers a sense of worth and belonging, and giving them opportunities to experience positive relationships with camp staff and with peers in a supportive environment. Camp is held on-site at Eagle Village and campers are housed in modern cabins.

*June 14-18 / June 28-July 2 - Cost: \$500 per camper*

## **SUMMER CAMP: FRONTIER CAMP**

Frontier Camp is a 5-day rustic camp experience for kids from ages 11 to 14. The program offers an increased level of challenge and opportunities to learn skills for overcoming adversity in a safe environment. Camp is held on-site at Eagle Village and campers are housed in rustic cabins.

*June 21-25 / Aug 2-6 - Cost: \$500 per participant*

## **SUMMER CAMP: PROJECT SURVIVE**

Project Survive is an effective alternative to boot camp for families who are wondering what to do with their defiant teen. This 9-day intensive wilderness experience is designed for 14- to 17-year-olds who are heading down a destructive path, skipping school or facing suspension, rebelling, and experimenting with illegal behaviors.

Camp is held on- and off-campus.

*July 8-16 / July 22-30 - Cost: \$1500 per participant*
