Acting out is a sign that something has gone wrong in a situation, not that something is wrong with a person.

Even the best parents run into struggles. A teen in the household suddenly pulls away. Their behavior changes. Suddenly they have new friends. Everything is a secret. They lash out. They self-harm. They skip school. They start doing drugs. Meanwhile, you can't sleep. All you do is worry. You talk to the doctor. The counselor. You take privileges away. You yell. You plead. You cry. But nothing changes—unless it just gets worse.

TAKING KIDS & FAMILIES TO THE NEXT LEVEL

Eagle Village has been utilizing the camp model for intervention purposes since we began over 50 years ago. Today, we continue to use the successful philosophies and theories of camp programming to help youth and their families press the restart button throughout the year.

Our staff members are trained to use techniques specific to kids with past trauma and emotional impairments to deal with:

- Defiance
- Depression
- Self-harm
- Lack of respect

- Extreme anger
- Bad attitudes
- Risky behaviors

Eagle Village uses challenging activities like canoeing, wilderness camping, mastering high ropes, and hiking in nature to serve as teachers. The activities teach natural consequences, decision making, trust, self-worth, perseverance, and goal setting in a true hands-on manner. For individual teens or entire families, Eagle Village's Short-Term Intervention Programs change attitudes and set a baseline for success.

At Eagle Village, we believe in the potential of all people regardless of their story.

SPECIALIZED SUMMER CAMPS

Eagle Village camps are best suited for kids and youth that are struggling to manage their anger or sadness, lacking respect for themselves or others, suffering from Reactive Attachment Disorder, or having problems taking personal responsibility.

SUMMER CAMP: BASE CAMP

Base Camp is a co-ed 5-day camp experience for kids ages 9-11. The program focuses on giving campers a sense of worth and belonging, and giving them opportunities to experience positive relationships with camp staff and with peers in a supportive environment. Camp is held on-site at Eagle Village and campers are housed by gender and age in cabins. If your camper requires one on one care, please inquire in advance to registering to ensure availability.

SUMMER CAMP: FRONTIER CAMP

Frontier Camp is a 5-day rustic camp experience, with separate sessions for boys and girls ages 11-14. The program offers an increased level of challenge and opportunities to learn skills for overcoming adversity in a safe environment. Camp is held on-site at Eagle Village and campers are housed in rustic cabins. If your camper requires one on one care, please inquire in advance to registering to ensure availability.

SUMMER CAMP: PROJECT SURVIVE

Project Survive is a 9-day intensive wilderness experience, with separate sessions for boys and girls who are 14-17 years old. This intervention is designed for teens who are struggling with behavior at home, school and in the community. They may be skipping school or facing suspension, described as rebellious, and/or experimenting with illegal behaviors. Camp includes 3 days on-site at Eagle Village in rustic cabins, and 5 days backpacking off-campus on the Manistee River Trail and North Country Trail.

WORKING AT CAMP

Our summer staff (ages 18+) works as a team to make our camps memorable, fun, safe and a growing experience for the kids that come to Eagle Village. Our camps serve as early intervention, skill building and additional support for kids who would struggle in a traditional camp setting. We have all the fun a regular camp would, but we also provide extra support to kids needing to work through emotions, taking responsibility for their actions and developing healthy relationships with peers and staff.
